The organization was formed in the summer of 1917 by a number of farmers self-help organizations. These organizations have been in existence for a good many years. In the spring of 1917, about the time that Mr. Hoover came to this country to take charge of what became known as the National Food Administration, a great many people came to Washington. It was to meet this situation that farm leaders came to the National Capital and they met in the various conferences before the war emergency boards, and out of the various meetings they decided it was advisable and necessary to form a national union, a clearing house, for their organizations so that they might have representation.
