Doubtless the severe weather we experienced in the spring of last year, when the Sedge-Warbler was due, was greatly to blame for the scarcity last season, and the decrease this year is the result. Although this bird may be scarce throughout the country, this year at Possil they are in greater numbers than in the previous year. The Sedge-Warbler is well known not only from its voluminous song during morning and evening, but also from its restless habits. I find that especially on its arrival, it is one of the most difficult birds to follow, on account of its rapid flights in and out amongst the low growths of the willows or thick vegetation. I found that, by lying concealed near some favourite bush, or near the reeds frequented by the birds, I was...
