Amongst Byron's best-known works are the brief poems *She Walks in Beauty*, and *So We'll Go no More a-Roving*, and the narrative poems *Childe Harold's Pilgrimage* (1812-1818) and *Don Juan* (1819-1824), although the latter remained incomplete on his death. He is regarded as one of the greatest European poets and remains widely read and influential, both in the English-speaking world and beyond. Byron served as a regional leader of Italy's revolutionary organization the Carbonari in its struggle against Austria. He later travelled to fight against the Ottoman Empire in the Greek War of Independence, for which Greeks revere him as a national hero. He died from a fever in Messolonghi in Greece. Amongst his other works are: *Fugitive Pieces* (1806), *Hours of Idleness* (also titled *Juvenilia*) (1807), *English Bards and Scotch Reviewers* (1809), *Hebrew Melodies* (1815), *The Prisoner of Chillon* (1816), *Manfred* (1817) and *The Works of Lord Byron* (7 volumes) (1898).
